# THE ROUND SYSTEM

## What is the Round System?

The Round System helps maximize the number of applicants admitted to cégep. There are three consecutive rounds for Fall semester applications.

A “round” is a portion of an application period during which:

- You can submit your application for the first time (at any round)
- You can change your choice and try again if you were refused at a previous round

With SRAM, you must choose a single program in a single cégep. If you are refused, you can take part in the following round for the same semester by making a new choice out of the remaining spaces. You will not have to pay additional application fees.

## Available spaces

In Round 1 of the Fall semester, the maximum number of spaces is open to applicants.

After Round 1 admissions, the remaining spaces are open in the next round. Since spaces are filled at each round, there are fewer spaces available as the application process moves forward. A Table of Available Spaces is published for Rounds 2 and 3. It is important to refer to these Tables prior to submitting a new choice.

If you are currently enrolled in school, SRAM highly encourages you to meet with your guidance counsellor to help prepare your college application.

## Acceptance

Admission is final. Once you are accepted, you may no longer take part in the following rounds.

## Refusal

If you are refused, you will be invited to take part in the next round. There are no additional fees. You just have to log on to your file at [admission.sram.qc.ca/my-file](http://admission.sram.qc.ca/my-file) and modify your choice before the next deadline.

## Admission answers

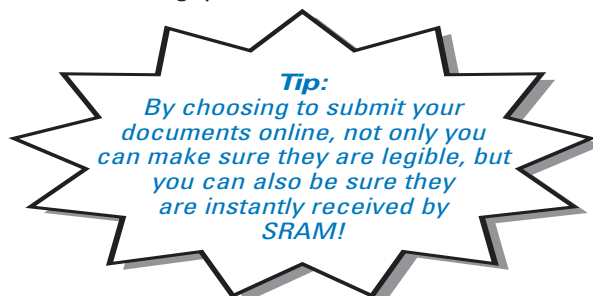
Admission answers are posted on your online file at [admission.sram.qc.ca/my-file](http://admission.sram.qc.ca/my-file) on the date listed in the deadlines and important dates of that round:

- Acceptance letters are sent directly from the cégeps. These letters include all the information needed to confirm your acceptance and your registration.
- Refusal letters are posted directly in the applicant’s online file. It should be read carefully as it includes explanations about the refusal, instructions to pursue the application and cegep contact information.

## Don’t wait until the last minute!

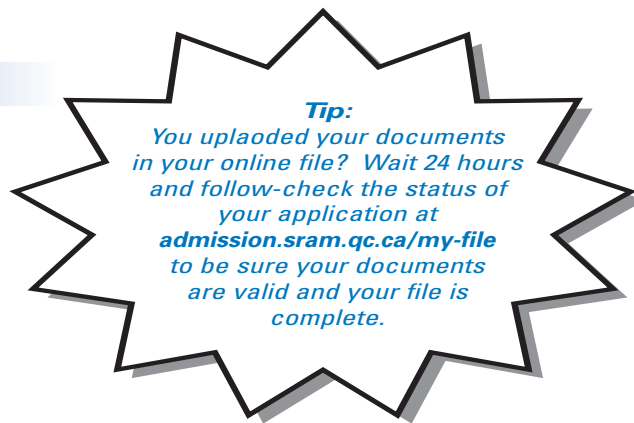
Submitting your application as soon as possible will give you plenty of time to complete your file before the deadline. Incomplete files are not sent out to cégeps for evaluation. So avoid last minute stress and complete admission file as soon as possible.

If you are hesitating between two programs or two cégeps, you can still start to fill out your application right away. As long as your application fees are paid, you can change your choice of program and cégep as many times as you wish right until the Round deadline. Your last registered choice at the time of the deadline is the one that will be considered.



## Why only one choice per round?

With the Round System, accepted applicants only reserve a single spot in a cégep. Cégeps therefore have a better grasp of the number of students they can accept and that will complete their registration with the cégep. As a result, SRAM's Round System makes it possible for a greater number of applicants to be accepted. In the Fall of 2020, 94.5% of applicants who followed through on all the rounds they were invited to were accepted.

\* An application is considered complete when applications fees have been paid and all mandatory documents have been received and deemed adequate by SRAM.

## A few telling statistics

Among the SRAM applicants to the Fall 2020 semester:

- 86% were accepted
- 94.5% applicants who followed through on all the rounds they were invited to were accepted
- 93% of applicants were accepted into their first choice program

There are, however, a certain number of programs with limited spaces due to one or many of the following reasons: limited number of laboratories, limited internships opportunities, and limited openings in the employment market.

## APPLYING FOR ADMISSION

- Have your permanent code on hand. This code is made up of 4 letters and 8 numbers and can be found on your ministry of Education transcripts.
- **Apply online at [admission.sram.qc.ca](http://admission.sram.qc.ca)**
- When you are done filling out your application, a list of documents needed to complete your file will be displayed. If you would like to see which documents will be requested before submitting an application, you may fill out a demo application at **[admission-demo.sram.qc.ca](http://admission-demo.sram.qc.ca)**. The list of documents to send in will also be displayed on the transmission receipt that you can print out after submitting your application. Some applicants will not have any documents to send in.
- A 30\$ application fee is required.
- If you have studied outside of Canada and require that SRAM prepares an *Evaluation of studies done outside of Canada* to complete your application, an additional 50\$ fee will apply.

### Paying fees and submitting documents

SRAM processes documents within 24 hours after their reception and will update your online file accordingly.

**IMPORTANT!** SRAM must receive your documents and payments before the deadline. The post's timestamp will not be considered.

**It is the applicant's duty to complete the admission file before the deadline. The applicant is responsible for sending in all required documents and following-up on their online file to ensure documents were received before deadline and accepted by SRAM.**

### Other requirements in some cases

The cégep could ask that a student born outside of Québec provide a proof of Québec residency.

The college may require applicants to pass a test, such as a language test. Fees may apply for this test.

Canadian students who are not considered Québec residents are subject to additional tuition fees of 3 242 \$ per semester. Students who are neither Canadian permanent residents nor Canadian citizens will have to pay yearly tuition fees ranging from 12 744 \$ to 19 754 \$, depending on the program of study. *Prices are set by the Ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur du Québec and are subject to change without notice.*

## GRADES AND TRANSCRIPTS

SRAM receives all your secondary and cégep grades previously obtained in Québec schools directly from the Ministry of Education. ▼

- ▼ If you are a Collège Stanislas or a Collège Marie-de-France student, you must provide copies of your transcripts from your last two secondary school years.

<b>If you are currently studying in a Québec secondary school, youth sector</b>	Your school or school board will send your grades directly to SRAM.
<b>If you are currently studying at the secondary school level, adult sector</b>	You have to ask your counsellor to send your Complementary Information on Adults' Academic Records to SRAM.
<b>If you have completed university studies</b>	Providing copies of your transcripts and diploma is highly recommended. However, these documents are not mandatory.
<b>If you have studied in a Canadian province other than Québec</b>	Copies of the following documents: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Transcripts from the last three years of secondary school</li> <li>• Diplomas (if graduated)</li> <li>• Transcripts from post-secondary studies, if applicable</li> </ul>

### Quality of documents:

Do not send original documents. The documents you provide must be clear and legible copies. Documents of poor quality or documents appearing to have been altered may be rejected. If a mandatory document is rejected, your file will remain incomplete and will be sent to the cégep for the current round when a satisfactory version has been received.

# DURATION OF STUDIES

## Duration of studies

- The minimum expected length of a pre-university program is 2 years or 4 semesters.
- The minimum expected length of a technical program is 3 years or 6 semesters.

# PRECISIONS

Important additional information or requirements apply to certain programs in certain cégeps. **The online table of available programs available at [admission.sram.qc.ca](http://admission.sram.qc.ca) details out all of these precisions.**

- A** Applicants to this program may be invited to tests and/or interviews and/or auditions that normally take place at this college. Fees are sometimes required.
- AA** Admission requirements for this program include Secondary 5 Chemistry or Chemistry 534 but an exemption issued by the ministère de l'Enseignement supérieur allows colleges to admit applicants who do not meet this requirement. However, a few particular colleges will not admit applicants who do not meet the Chemistry prerequisite. Consult the college's website for information on admission requirements.
- C** Administration and registration fees are required for the International Baccalaureate exams.
- D** Applicants must comply with the prerequisites of these two programs. Please consult the cégep's website to see if there are options to choose from.
- E** Applicants choosing Springboard to a DCS have to verify which services are available in this preparatory session by consulting their chosen cégep's website.
- F** Applicants to this program may be required to take a medical examination or get vaccinations.
- G** This program pertains to students who have obtained a specific SSVD. Please consult the cégep's website to verify the admission requirements.
- I** Some cégeps require applicants to this program to consult their website regarding interview, audition, exam or test schedules.
- JA** For this program, some colleges have additional requirements or instructions for admission. Consult the college's website for more information.
- K** To inquire about the required driver's license, please consult the cégep's website.
- L** In Collège Montmorency the 3rd year of this program takes place at l'Institut de tourisme et d'hôtellerie du Québec, in Montréal.
- LA** In Sorel-Tracy and Valleyfield cégeps the 4th and 5th semesters of this program will take place at l'Institut de tourisme et d'hôtellerie du Québec, in Montréal.
- LC** In Cégep de l'Abitibi-Témiscamingue - campus de Val d'Or this program is offered in partnership with Collège Rosemont: the 3rd and 4th semesters are held at Collège Rosemont (in Montréal). Mandatory internships included in the 5th and 6th semesters could also take place in Montréal.
- LD** In Cégep de Saint-Hyacinthe, during his studies, the student will need to commute between Saint-Hyacinthe and Montréal, according to a schedule defined at the beginning of each semester.
- LF** For Collège Maisonneuve the students will have to take classes in Montréal and Cégep régional de Lanaudière à Joliette, according to a schedule set in the beginning of each semester. Transportation between the two colleges is organized by the College.
- LG** At Cégep de l'Abitibi-Témiscamingue, this program is offered in collaboration with Cégep Beauce-Appalaches. The first three semesters will be held in Campus Lac-Mégantic.
